Eurosystem standards for the use of triparty agents (TPAs) in Eurosystem credit operations

Public consultation on the Guide to on-site inspections and internal model investigations

On 25 July 2017 the Governing Council did not object to the proposal of the Supervisory Board to launch a public consultation on the Guide to on-site inspections and internal model investigations. Following the assessment of comments made during the public consultation, the final Guide is expected to be submitted to the Supervisory Board for approval and to the Governing Council for adoption during the last quarter of 2017.
