

## Loans to non-financial corporations – France • February 2019

### Growth of equipment loans remains sustained

- Growth in investment loans to non-financial corporations accelerates in February (+6.3% in February 2019 year-on-year, up from +6.1% in January 2019) driven by both equipment loans (+7.0%, up from +6.8% in January) and real estate loans (+5.3%, up to 5.1% in January).
- Growth in treasury loans is steady (+6.5%).
- Overall, the annual growth rate of loans to NFCs, which is almost stable, remains very dynamic at +6.1% in February 2019 (up from 6.0% in January).

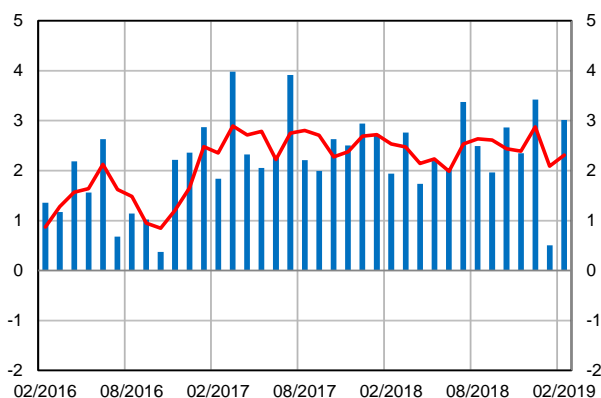

### Monthly changes in stocks of equipment loans (seasonally adjusted flows)

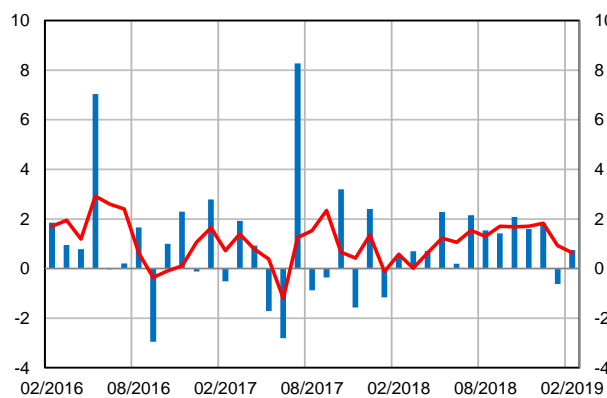
(Monthly flows in € Bn)

### Additional information

Non-financial corporations include all companies whose main activity is the production of goods and non-financial services, excluding sole proprietor and unincorporated partnerships.

Calculations are made with the aim to give the best possible image of the evolution of the lending activity:

- Loans that have been securitized or sold by credit institutions are considered as remaining in their books
- Accounting changes that are not reflecting economic transactions, in particular write-offs/write-downs, are eliminated
- The impact of statistical modifications in the scope of the MFI sector (e.g. the reclassification of an entity from the non-financial corporations sector to the government sector) is also eliminated
- As FX hedges are unknown, loans in foreign currencies are however taken into account at their face value in Euros at the end of the month
